

**MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL AND MAY, 2023
HELD ON 01-07-2023 AT 2:00 PM AT BASHBARI HIGH SCHOOL, KOKRAJHAR**

Members Present: at **Annexure – I.**

The meeting was chaired by Smti Varnali Deka, IAS, Secretary, BTC cum Deputy Commissioner, Kokrajhar. The meeting was held at Bashbari High School, a border village of the District. The meeting was historical because for the first time, a DDC meeting was held at a Border Village. At the very outset, Secretary, BTC cum Deputy Commissioner, Kokrajhar, Smti Varnali Deka welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Initiating the discussion, the Chairperson reviewed department wise actionable points of last month's DDC meeting held on 27-04-2023 and took stock of the progress of all inter and intra departmental issues and the developmental schemes one by one.

After review of the Minutes of the last DDC Meeting & the Power Point Presentations prepared by the departments following observations & decisions were made:-

1) KVK

- Asstt. Director, KVK informed the house that on the occasion of 'International Millet Year' a millet receive competition was organised in three blocks of Kokrajhar District Viz Hatidhura Block, Gossaigoan and Kachugaon Block on 13th, 14th and 15th June 2023 and 05 toppers was selected from each block and thus 15 toppers was known as 'Millet education ambassador' of the district.
- Asstt. Director, KVK highlighted the fish breeding at Dhauliguri, Gossaigaon in Collaboration with Department of Fisheries, Kokrajhar.

2) Forest Department:-

- DFO, Kachugaon Division informed the house about year wise revenue collection upto May 2023 for the FY 2022-23 is Rs. **1.57 Cr.**
(Action DFO, Kachugaon Division)
- DFO, Parbatjhora Division informed the house about the revenue collection for the FY 2022-23 was Rs **23.72 Lakhs.**
(Action DFO, Parbatjhora Division)
- DFO, Parbatjhora further informed the house that in the FY 2023-24, out of 17 timber lots, only 8 nos. of timber lots have been disposed through auction in Parbatjhora division. (Action DFO, Parbatjhora Division)
- DFO, Haltugaon Division informed the house about the revenue collection upto May for the FY 2022-23 was Rs. **20.18 Lakhs.**
(Action DFO, Haltugaon Division)
- The Chairperson instructed the DFO's Kachugaon, Parbatjhora and Haltugaon to increase the Revenue for the FY 2023-24.

3) Sericulture Department

- Asstt. Director of sericulture, Kokrajhar informed the house that 230 Nos. of beneficiary has been selected under Eri sector under Silk Samagra-2.
- Asstt. Director of sericulture, Kokrajhar informed the house that the production of Eri cut Cucoon and Muga Raw Silk during the month of May, 2023 was 45,340 kg and 252 kg respectively.

4) Taxes Department :-

- The Supdt. of Taxes, Kokrajhar informed the house that the revenue collection upto the month of May, 2023 was Rs. **1560.61 lakhs** against the target of Rs. **1155.00 lakhs.**

(Action: Supdt. of Taxes, Kokrajhar)

5) APDCL:-

- On the issue of planning for grid connectivity in char areas discussed in last DC's Conference, CEO, APDCL Kokrajhar informed the house that A survey has been conducted in **Garumarachar - I, Garumarachar – II, Simultapu block, Khokhshaguri Block and Bangalijhora villages** and an estimate amounting to **Rs.11,92,83,219.00** (Eleven Crores Ninety two Lakhs Eighty Three Thousand Two Hundred and Nineteen Only) has been proposed to CGM(RE) and the approval is yet to be received.

(Action: CEO, APDCL Kokrajhar)

- The CEO, APDCL informed the house that as per direction given by Principal Secretary, BTR the compiled JJM electricity bills have been submitted to the office of the Director, P&RD, BTR.

(Action: CEO, APDCL Kokrajhar)

- As per direction given by Principal Secretary, BTR installation of smart prepaid meters in all offices under BTC is under process and till date 40 nos. of meters have already installed. (Action: CEO, APDCL Kokrajhar)

6) Transport Department :-

- The DTO, Kokrajhar informed the house that the revenue collected till May, 2023 was Rs. **3.94 Cr** against the target of **27 Cr.** for the FY 2023-24 as compared to **2.93 Cr.** till May, 2022 for the FY 2022-23 .

- The DTO, Kokrajhar informed the house that -

- a) The department convened meeting with all the chairman/chairpersons of VDCs of Kokrajhar District where they are requested to conduct road safety and awareness program in the village level.
- b) In fatal accident sites of the district, the Crash Investigation Team, the District administration and the District police administration have been investigating and surveying for the last one year for remedial measures to stop accidents in those fatal sites.
- c) Road safety and awareness program will be conducted with Principals of all the colleges, Higher secondary Schools and Head Master of all the High schools of the district.

- The chairperson instructed the DTO Kokrajhar to expedite revenue collection/ enforcement drives in the district and assured of him providing all necessary help from the district administration in this regard.

(Action: DTO, Kokrajhar)

7) Industries & Commerce Department :-

- The EE, PHE Kokrajhar has requested for permission to install power substation within the office campus of ADCI office for water supply scheme under JJM. In this regard GM, DICC informed that the matter is taken up with CHD for consideration. The Chairperson directed GM, DICC to follow up the matter.

(Action: GM ,DICC, Kokrajhar)

- The GM, DICC, Kokrajhar further informed the house that in absence of officer of KVIC at Kokrajhar, the performance of PMEGP has suffered and for FY 2022-23 , KVIC has achieved only 8.43% of the physical target.

- While reviewing the present status of DICC department, it is reported that 13(DICC), 7(KVIC) and 2(KVIB) no. of applications under PMEGP are pending with Banks. (Action: LDM Kokrajhar)

- Under PMFME, total 126 nos. of application are pending with bank. (Action: LDM Kokrajhar)

- Also under One District One Product (ODOP), total 136 nos of application are pending with Bank Branch. Secretary BTC asked LDM to review and take up with concerned banks having pendency.

(Action: LDM Kokrajhar)

- LDM was instructed to submit rejection list to DICC with detail reasons and also instructed to look into the pendency regarding PMEGP and PMFME and expedite the process of disposal of the said applications.

(Action: LDM Kokrajhar)

8) Labour Department :-

- The House instructed the Labour Officer cum CHD to increase the drives for detection of Child Labour and take necessary action for prosecution of the violators of the Child Labour Act.

(Action: Labour Officer, Kokrajhar)

9) Education Department :-

- The House instructed IS, Kokrajhar to make frequent visits of the schools located in Santhali Areas of the district and to share all list of schools located in Santhali Areas to HODs of departments
(Action: IS, Kokrajhar)
- On the issue of take measures to reduce the dropout rate at all the level, with a special focus on secondary level discussed in **DC Conference wef 15th-17th May, 2023 at Tinsukia**, IS, Kokrajhar highlighted that All the interventions for covering drop out students like KGBV, RSTC and NRSTCs already covered the drop out students. Also proposal submitted to State Mission Office for providing special training to HS drop out students under NIOS.
- He further informed that Rationalization process is going on at District level regarding possibility of posting local tea tribe teachers in tea garden schools as mentioned in the **DC Conference wef 15th-17th May, 2023 at Tinsukia**.
- On the issue of taking explanation from the poorly performing districts in Gunotsav along with facilitating celebration of district with high ranks in Gunotsav discussed in **DC Conference wef 15th-17th May, 2023 at Tinsukia**, IS, Kokrajhar informed that Already explanation has been served to poor performing schools and facilitated the A plus Schools.
- The house was found that Instruction has given to the schools to seed the Aadhar number of the students in UDISE portal.
- Principal DPO, SSA informed the house that there are 250 and 998 nos. of out-of-school-children (6-14) years who are not mainstreamed and proposed to be continued for special training for the year 2023-24 under Residential Special Training Centre (RSTC) and Non Residential Special Training Centre (NRSTC) respectively.

10) Women & Child Welfare Department:-

- On the issue of Abolition of child Marriage and bring onboard the GP secretaries / Presidents of concerned GPs to work at the grassroots level in a comprehensive manner so that within 2026 there are no cases of child marriage in Assam discussed in **DC Conference wef 15th-17th May, 2023 at Tinsukia**. The DSWO informed the house that the District Administration, Kokrajhar has notified a committee in the district with VCDC Chairman as the Chairperson of the committee, OC/IC of the concerned PS and OP, Lot Mandals and representative from Department of Education, Health, Social Welfare as its member. The committee has been instructed to sit a monthly meeting to review on cases or potential cases of child marriage of the concerned areas.
- The DSWO further informed the house that The **Village Level Child Protection Committee (VLCPC)** has also been activated in the entire district to work on various child protection issues.
(Action: DSWO; Kokrajhar)
- The house was found that all the mismatch data in attendance and the enrollment in AWCs has been rectified and corrected at POSHAN Tracker.
- On the issue of to list out 10 worst performing districts regarding Anganwadi related parameter, discussed in **DC Conference wef 15th-17th May, 2023 at Tinsukia**, The DSWO reported that The Director of department will identify the worst performing district.
- The DSWO informed the house that there are 10 nos. of awareness programmes like Door to door Campaign, Meetings, School visit by the Officers conducted in collaboration with line departments of the Kokrajhar district against child marriage and also 1(one) incident of child marriage is prevented in Kokrajhar District.
(Action: DSWO; Kokrajhar)

- The DSWO informed the house that out of 1687 Anganwadi Centers 1659 nos have been adopted. (98.34% Anganwadi Centres adopted)
- The DSWO informed the house that out of 24 nos. of Model Anganwadi centres, 22 nos has been completed and the remaining two are under construction. *(Action: DSWO; Kokrajhar)*

11) Handloom & Textile Department:-

- While reviewing the present status of H&T department, the Asstt. Director of H&T informed the house that under the 2nd Phase Swanirbhar Naari Scheme 133 nos. of registration done by the weavers through the portal of swanirbharnaari.assam.gov. till the month of May and awareness programme along with registration of weavers is going on simultaneously.
- The Asstt. Director of H&T informed the house that 11 nos. of applications of weavers MUDRA Loan have been submitted to the Punjab National Bank, Kokrajhar

12) ASRLM :-

- House reviewed the ongoing schemes & no vital issue has been raised by this department.

13) Library Department :-

- The District Librarian informed the house that the Construction of Sub-Divisional Library, Parbatjhora is yet to be completed. Accordingly the EE, PWD (Building), Kokrajhar was requested to complete it before the next DDC meeting. *(Action: District Librarian, EE, PWD (Building), Kokrajhar)*
- On the issue of providing protection at Sub-Divisional Library, Gossaigaon, The EE WRD , Kokrajhar informed the house that the proposal regarding the scheme named " Anti- erosion measures to protect Gossaigaon Sub-Divisional Library from the erosion of the river Modati on its river bank under SOPD (BTC) for 2003-24" with an estimated amount of Rs. 30.60 lakh has been submitted to BTC.

(Action: EE WRD , Kokrajhar)

14) Fishery Department:-

- DFDO informed the house that total 9 nos of scheme under PMMSY are going on with 25% progress.

(Action: DFDO, Kokrajhar)

15) Skill Employment & Entrepreneurship Department:-

- The CHD, SEED informed in the house that total enrollment of ITI Kokrajhar under PMKVY 4.0 is 36 against the target of 240 for the FY 2023-24. *(Action: CHD, SEED, Kokrajhar)*
- The House reviewed the ongoing 13 nos. schemes and no vital issues has been raised by the Department.

16) Excise Department:-

- Supdt. of Excise Kokrajhar informed the house that revenue collection for the month of April and May, 2023 was Rs. 3.33 Cr against target of Rs. 12.13 Cr during FY 2023-24 as compared to 1.55 cr for the month of April and May, 2022. *(Action: Supdt. of Excise, Kokrajhar)*

17) Agriculture Department :-

- The House reviewed the ongoing 17 nos. schemes of the department, such as PM KISAN, PMFBY.
- Regarding PM KISAN, the house requested to all HODs to share the information about the benefits of the PM KISAN scheme as and when they visit the villages. The District Agriculture Officer Kokrajhar is requested to take all steps to enhance the performance of the scheme.

(Action: DAO, Kokrajhar, All HODs)

- DAO informed the house that total application sponsored under Kishan Credit Card is 1353 and the no of application sanctioned by Banks is 525. He requested to the LDM, Kokrajhar to expedite the pending application clearance.

(Action: LDM, Kokrajhar)

- DAO informed that under PM FBY, total 6258 nos of farmers are registered for Rabi crops against the target of 12000. *(Action: DAO, Kokrajhar, All HODs)*

18) Public Works Department (Roads) :-

- The EE, PWD (Roads) Kokrajhar, highlighted the construction of road inside Bodoland University campus in connection with International Knowledge Festival and the construction of road for Bodo Sahitya Sabha session 2023 at Patgaon.
- The Secretary cum Deputy Commissioner requested to EE, PWD (Roads), Kokrajhar to adopt Green Technology while constructing roads. (Action EE, PWD (R),Kokrajhar)

19) Public Works Department (Building Division) :-

- The House was informed by the EE, PWD, Kokrajhar & Chirang Dist., Territorial Building Division that
 - a) Construction of Administrative Building attached to B.B. Engineering College, Kokrajhar is 52% complete
 - b) Construction of Auditorium of 1000 seats attached to B.B. Engineering College, Kokrajhar is 45% completed. (Action: EE, PWD (Building), Kokrajhar)
 - c) Construction of proposed RCC 2(two) storied Girls' Hostel at BB Engineering College, Kokrajhar is 75% completed.
 - d) Construction of E.M Quarter (G+5) at BTC, Kokrajhar (20 units) under grants to BTC for Infrastructure Development is 35.00% Physical Progressed. (Action: EE, PWD (Building), Kokrajhar)
 - e) Construction of MCLA Quarter (G+5) at BTC, Kokrajhar (30 units) (Including Civil, Electrical, Sanitary, Plumbing, water supply works, Site Development, Furniture, Air Conditioner, Gym Equipment etc.) under Infrastructure Development is 30% progressed. (Action: EE, PWD (Building), Kokrajhar)

20) Public Works Department (Electrical Division) :-

- The EE PWD (E) informed the house that the plan & estimate of the bundling of wires on both side of the road in Kokrajhar town area has been prepared & submitted for approval. (Action: EE, PWD (E), Kokrajhar)

21) Irrigation Department:-

- The EE Irrigation, Kokrajhar informed the house that under M&R (Maintenance and Repair), out of 7 nos. of schemes, 5(five) were completed and remaining 2(two) is in progress for the FY 2022-23.
- The EE Irrigation, Kokrajhar informed the house that total Area Covered through irrigation so far in Kokrajhar District is 26663 Hectares. (Action: EE Irrigation , Kokrajhar)

22) Public Health Engineer Department:-

- The EE, PHE Kokrajhar informed the house that out of total 242 nos. of trained Jal Mitras, 231 nos of engagement letters were given .
- The EE, PHE Kokrajhar informed the house that under JJM, 835 nos. of FHTC achieved for 2023-24 against the target of 1800 . (Action: EE PHE , Kokrajhar)
- The EE, PHE Kokrajhar also informed the house that under JJM, 7687 nos of IHHL achieved for FY 2022-23 against the target of 7872 nos for FY 2022-23. (Action: EE PHE , Kokrajhar)

23) Water Resource Department :-

- On the issue of providing protection at Sub-Divisional Library, Gossaigaon, the EE WRD ,Kokrajhar informed the house that the proposal regarding the scheme named " Anti- erosion measures to protect Gossaigaon Sub-Divisional Library from the erosion of the river Modati on its river bank under SOPD (BTC) for 2003-24" with an estimated amount of Rs. 30.60 lakh has been submitted to BTC. (Action: EE, PWD (Building), Kokrajhar)

24) Housing & Urban Department:-

The Urban development department, Kokrajhar highlighted that out of total target of 4928 nos. house, total 3255 nos. of PMAY(U) house is completed.

(Action: Deputy Director ,Town& Country Planning , Kokrajhar)

25) Soil Conservation Department

- House reviewed the ongoing schemes under SOPD-G and RIDF & no vital issue has been raised by this department.

(Action: DO, Soil Conservation, Kokrajhar)

26) Health & Family Welfare Department

- Jt .DHS informed the house that the IMR and MMR are much below the target. During 2022-23 IMR and MMR are 245 and 14 respectively.

- Jt .DHS informed the house that total nos. of e-KYC for Ayushman Card done is 4,68,820 which is 67% of total beneficiaries.

(Action: Jt. DHS , Kokrajhar)

- On the issue of low percentage of night C-Section, Jt .DHS informed the house that there is no. Anethologist in SDCH Gossaigaon and only one in the Kokrajhar District Civil Hospital due to which the percentage of night C-Section is low.

(Action: Jt. DHS , Kokrajhar)

27) Economics and Statistics Department

- The Deputy Director of Economics & Statistics, Kokrajhar highlighted the works conducted by the department such as Census, Crop Cutting Experiment, Area Enumeration of Areca nut, Coconut, Fruits & Vegetables (ACFV) , Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojona, the Rape & Mustard & Potato, Crop Cutting Experiment (CCE) 2022-23 etc and no vital issue has been raised by this department.

(Action: Deputy Director, Economics & Statistics, Kokrajhar)

- The Deputy Director of Economics & Statistics, Kokrajhar informed the house that the crop cutting experiment of Summer paddy is going on the field and also the total no. of experiment is 160, out of which 92 nos plot selection has been completed.

28) A.H & Veterinary Deptt, Kokrajhar

- District A.H. & Veterinary Officer, Kokrajhar highlighted progress report on treatment, castration & vaccination of cattles and also status of govt. livestock farms, Kokrajhar.

29) Tourism Deptt, Kokrajhar

- Director cum CHD, Tourism, BTC highlighted the achievement of SOPD scheme for the FY 2022-23 and also highlighted the proposed SOPD scheme for the FY 2023-24.

30) DRDA, Kokrajhar

- On the issue of the importance of PMAY houses and MNREGA asset creation in the tea garden areas discussed in **last DC's Conference**, Project Director, DRDA informed the house that Project Director, 3 Nos of Tea Garden fall in Kokrajhar district. 88 nos of schemes taken up under MGNREGA during FY 2022-23 & out of which 66 nos schemes have been completed (75%). Moreover, 22 nos of schemes have been taken up under MGNREGA in Tea garden area for the year 2023-24 which are in progress.

(Action: Project Director ,DRDA)

- On the issue of excavation work of the Amrit Sarovar by 31 July and MGNREGA related works at Amrit Sarovar by 15th of August **discussed in last DC's Conference**, Project Director, DRDA also informed **71 nos** of Amrit Sarovar have been completed out of 76 nos (93%). The remaining **5 nos** will be completed within 31st July;2023.

(Action: Project Director ,DRDA)

- He also informed that the plantation including waiting shed under MGNREGA in Amrit Sarovar are in progress and will be completed within stipulated time.

(Action: Project Director ,DRDA)

- Project Director, DRDA further informed that the Paver block roads are being constructed under MGNREGA maintaining the wage material ratio with NRM works in the same VCDCs.

(Action: Project Director ,DRDA)

- On the issue of Brown field Amrit Sarovars to be preferred to the green fields discussed in **last DC's Conference**, Project Director, DRDA informed that **25 Nos** of brown Amrit Sarovar have been identified to convert green field. The blockwise details are as follows: **Debitola dev. Block: 8 nos, Chapor Salkocha dev. Block :9 Mahmaya Dev. Block : 7nos, Bilasipara Dev. Block: 1**

➤ Joint Director Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, BTC, Kokrajhar informed the house that out of 126984 of target, 80268 nos. of application has been received under NFSA in Kokrajhar District.

33) Co-operative Societies

- DRCS, Kokrajhar informed the House that for Introduction of Common Service Centre, 25 PACS has already been whitelisted under Kokrajhar District out of which 17 Nos PACS have already been received IDs.
- DRCS, Kokrajhar requested the departments such as agriculture, Fishery, H&T, Sericulture, DICC etc. to provide facilitation skills with handholding training in a scientific way and implement viable schemes through the registered co-operatives societies at least 5 nos. in each sectors on priority basis.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the chair.
